DISASTER SURVIVAL KIT

In the event of an emergency or disaster, you will need a Disaster Survival kit that you can use at home or take with you in case you must evacuate the area. Basic supplies in this kit include the following:

- Water— 1 gallon per person, per day. 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-weeks, home.
- Food—non-perishable items. 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home.
- Manual can opener.
- Flashlights.
- Battery-powered radio.
- Two-way radios
- Extra batteries.
- Cell phone with charger.
- First Aid Kit.
- Medications 7-day supply.
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items.
- Personal documents medications, proof of address, passports, insurance policies, etc.
- Family and emergency contact information.
- Extra cash, credit and ATM cards.
- Blankets, towels, sleeping bags and pillows.
- Local and state maps.
- Hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, etc.
- Baby supplies bottles, formula, baby food, diapers.
- Games for children.
- Pet supplies collar, leash, ID, food, carrier, bowl.
- Extra set of car keys and house keys.
- Whistle.
- Surgical masks.
- Matches.
- Rain gear.
- Work gloves.
- Tools/supplies for securing your home.
- Extra clothing, hat and work shoes.
- Plastic sheeting.
- Duct tape.
- Scissors.
- Household liquid bleach.
